

# TO CHECK ATTENDANCE/LOGINS

1. Go to <https://www.thelearningodyssey.com/>

2. Type in your son or daughter's username and password

username: s number (s123456)

password: 1617 birth month and day (1617Feb23)

3. Make sure under school it says rUSD, or you type RUUSD, in place of ODYSSEY




1. Go to <https://www.thelearningodyssey.com/>

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
