HERE ARE JUST A FEW OF THE AVAILABLE SCHOOLS AND PROGRAMS TO CHOOSE FROM:

Dual Language Program – Prepares bilingual and biliterate students to achieve high levels of success academically, linguistically and socially. To learn more and find out which schools offer a dual language program, visit www.rusd.org.

Parent-Child Oriented Classroom (PCOC) | Age 3 –
Located at Red Apple Early Childhood and Goodland Elementary, this program for 3-year-olds allows parents to work with their children in the classroom once a week.

Montessori Program | Ages 3 and up –
The Montessori program is based on self-directed activities in multi-age classrooms that emphasize learning through all five senses.

Red Apple Elementary | K-5 – A STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) magnet school providing students with many projects and interactive learning opportunities.

Jefferson Lighthouse Elementary, International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme | K-5 –
An IB Primary Years Programme school offering inquiry-led, rigorous curriculum that encourages students to explore local and global issues as well as a second language.

Gilmore Fine Arts | K-8 – Offers a world-class, fine arts program with specialized instruction in art, instrumental music, choral music, drama and dance.

Starbuck Middle School, International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme | 6-8 – The IB Programme at Starbuck, an IB World School, is designed to develop active learners and internationally minded students through rigorous curriculum and project-based learning.

Walden III | 6-12 – Named one of the best high schools in the nation by U.S. News & World Report, Walden III offers a small, close-knit learning environment, in which faculty members work to find unique ways to motivate each individual student.

The R.E.A.L. School | 6-12 – The Racine Engineering, Arts and Leadership School offers a small, tight-knit learning environment in a beautiful, newly redesigned facility. In partnership with Gateway Technical College, The R.E.A.L. School offers engineering classes through the SC Johnson iMET Center.

Racine Virtual Learning | 5-12 – Online courses offer students an alternative to the traditional classroom. Students can choose from more than 350 courses.

The Academies of Racine | 9-12 – Students attending Case, Horlick and Park High Schools all have an opportunity to be part of the Academies of Racine. Students select pathways to explore career choices and experience hands-on, real-world learning. Students can also take part in college visits, internships, apprenticeships, career fairs and more.
