



Dear Parent/Guardian:

Advanced Placement testing is right around the corner. AP exams are scheduled from May 11<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup>, and late testing dates are June 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>. This letter will provide you with a brief overview. If you would like more information, please visit the District AP webpage at [www.rusd.org/AP](http://www.rusd.org/AP).

- AP exams consists of 45-minute online exam that will occur May 11<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> and be completed at home. Exam sessions begin at 11:00, 1:00, and 3:00 depending on the subject area exam (see schedule on back)
- Late exams will occur June 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> with the same exam format and session times. We are encouraging students to take exams during the regular exam period to avoid taking multiple exams during the same session.
- AP Seminar, Research, Computer Science Principles performance tasks, and Studio Art portfolios must be complete by May 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Exams are best completed on a laptop or desktop computer, but a smartphone or tablet may be utilized.
- AP Spanish and French exams must be completed on an IOS or Android tablet or smartphone.
- Students will receive a unique exam code from the College Board at the email address they used to register for the exam. Please ensure your student updates their email address if need be and can access their email to receive the code.
- All students should access the College Board exam demo prior to the day of their exam to ensure they are able to access and navigate the exam administration system.
- Notes and textbooks may be used on the exam, but students cannot collaborate with other exam participants. The College Board will have security measures in place, cheating or plagiarism will result in cancellation of scores.
- If your student is no longer interested in taking the exam, no further action is needed. Exam codes that are not utilized will result in student's exams being cancelled without the \$40 cancellation fee. If you paid the exam fee, it will be refunded after the College Board issues the final invoice in June.
