As we worked to plan this important event, we worked closely with the local health departments, CDC and the Racine Unified School District to follow CDC guidelines to keep our staff, students and parents/guardians safe. Through this guidance we are required to keep the number of people in one location at a total of 25 people or under. This includes staff, students and parents/guardians. Therefore, each graduate will be allowed to have one vehicle for Graduation 2020. As in years past, we have set a limit of the number of people each graduate can bring. **Therefore, each vehicle will be allowed to have 4 people and the graduate for a total of 5 people. Vehicles not adhering to these guidelines will not be allowed to participate.**

All vehicles will enter off of Rapids Drive by the tennis courts and line up. There will be several stop points along the way. Each vehicle will be checked for the number of occupants and the graduate will be given a name card to fill out. At the next stop graduates will receive a Graduation 2020 facemask and at the final stop they will get out of the car, hand their name card to the Academy Principal to be read and walk across the stage. Students will move their tassel from right to left and exit the stage. They will pick up their diplomas and any other awards they may have received. Professional photographs will photograph each student as they cross the stage and receive their diploma cover. No payment at commencement will be required. Proofs will be sent to your home after the ceremony. These pictures will also be used for the video that is being created.

As in years past, caps and gowns cannot be decorated and proper conduct on everyone's part is expected. Parents and family members need to stay in their cars at all times.
