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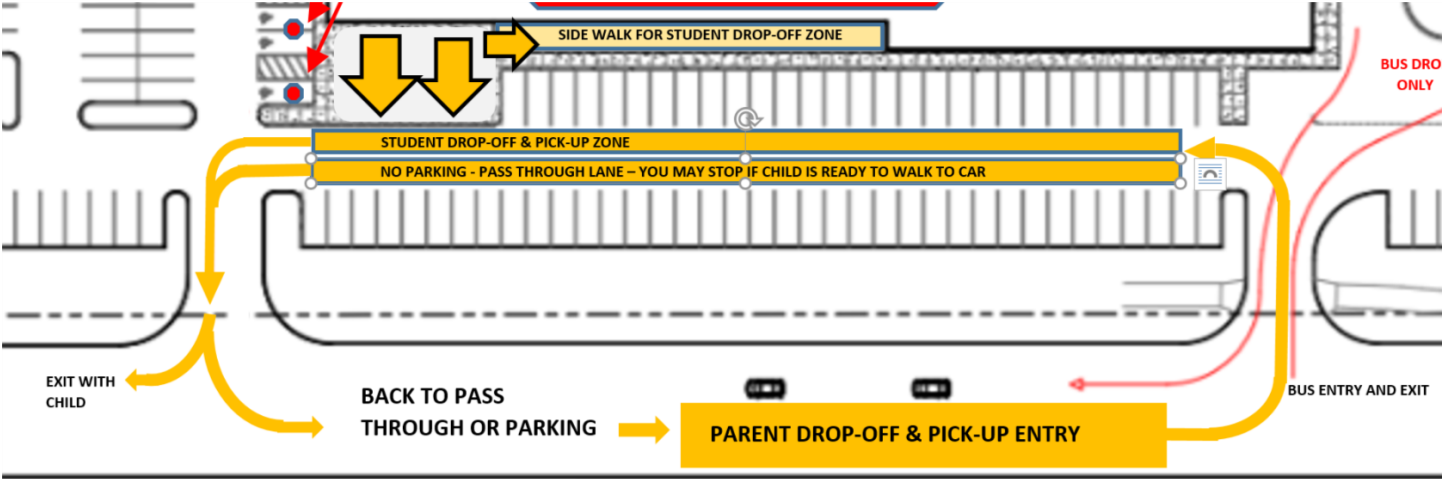

The middle school students at The REAL School have the opportunity to enroll in the Intra/Extramural sports program throughout this year. Here is a list of the dates and sports for the 2018-2019 school year.

Other important information:

- Intra/Extramural sports are designed for seventh and eighth graders. If there aren't enough students of that particular class, sixth graders will be allowed to participate on a seventh-grade team.
- There are 3 forms plus a physical, signed by a physician, must be completed before any athlete can participate in any games or matches.
- There is a \$30 fee that is due for each sport (see athletic code sheet for more information).
- Transportation will **not** be provided home from practices nor games. Parents must be available to pick up their children after practices (4:15pm) and after games(TBA).
- A typical season begins with 2 weeks of practice and then games will occur against other middle schools the last 4 weeks of the season.
- Games, matches, and meets are held throughout a variety of middle and high schools. Pick up times and location will be given out during the first week of practice.
