Providing a safe and secure learning environment for your child is one of Racine Unified's top priorities. To ensure we accomplish this, we regularly review and update our safety and security procedures. As a result, we have updated our lockdown procedures, which are set into motion in the unlikely event that a threat of danger exists in or around our schools.

Beginning in the 2018-19 school year, RUSD implemented the use of ALiCE, an active shooter response training program, (i.e. alert, lockdown, inform, counter and evacuate) in all of our schools. Security experts across the country believe, as do we, that the use of these additional procedures will enhance student and staff safety.

For the last several months, all RUSD staff members including principals and teachers, took part in ALiCE training, as well as our students.
