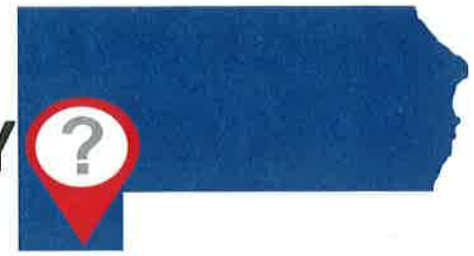


# WHERE TO GO TO GET VACCINATED IN RACINE COUNTY



## Option 1: Contact your doctor's office for an appointment.

## Option 3: Make an appointment with your local health department.
